



## **Dual Enrollment at GCH**

Partnership with Christian Halls and Southeastern University

### **Q: What ages can participate?**

A: We are currently offering classes for Juniors and Seniors (16-18 year olds)

### **Q: What does it cost and how do I pay?**

A: The cost breakdown is as follows:

\$100/credit hour, or \$300 per course

\$175 technology fee/semester = \$350/yr

\$50 one-time CHI membership fee

Because of our partnership with Christian Halls, SEU bills us for the cost of the classes and you can then pay GCH directly with private funds or a Step Up Scholarship. The only money that you will need to pay out of pocket is the \$50 CHI membership fee that is charged when you register (see directions below).

### **Q: Does my student need to pass the PERT to take college classes this way?**

A: No. Because of our relationship with Christian Halls, no testing is required to register for dual enrollment classes.

### **Q: How does it work?**

A: Great question. I'm glad you asked. As a homeschool family, you can take dual enrollment classes through us whether you come to our school full time or only for the college classes. It looks like this:

Your high schooler becomes an SEU student and is registered for one of the SEU courses that we are offering. The college professor of that course is responsible for assigning and grading their work but does not teach them online. During the week, your student meets with a "tutor" at GCH who helps him/her understand how to navigate the college online portal, and organize, understand, and complete her assignments. According to the "Oxford" tutoring used by CHI, the tutor will also help the student really dig into the content of the course and make sure they are engaging with the concepts in a rigorous way that will prepare them for college-level thinking and work. Because of the high quality of work that the student can create using this style of tutoring, we can be confident that their work will be good and that they will earn good college grades on their high school transcript. This will look very good when applying to colleges in the future and make them very competitive in whatever school they want to apply to.

**Q: Does it go on my transcript?**

A: Yes. The courses from SEU go onto your high school transcript as accredited courses. **When it comes to your ability to transfer these courses to other schools, it can depend on the receiving school, so be sure to ask the college you apply to.**

**Q: What is the schedule?**

A:

- 1) **Deadline** to register with SEU: Aug 8, 2024
  - a) Register with SEU and designate that you are a CHI dual enrollment student
  - b) Sign up for your classes
- 2) Start of GCH classes: Aug 12, 2024
- 3) Access to IEW Composition 1 class (16-week course) on Aug 14, 2024 . (Tutor ensures that all students complete the ***Attendance activity*** and helps students organize their materials for their Dual Enrollment classes)
- 4) IEW Composition 1 begins (16-week course): Aug 21, 2024
- 5) American History and College Algebra Courses access (8-week courses): Oct 9, 2024
- 6) American History and College Algebra Courses first day of class: Oct 16, 2024
- 7) Registration for all SEU Spring and Summer classes opens: Nov 4, 2024

*Thanksgiving Breaks will be described in the course syllabus*

- 8) Last day for all SEU Fall courses: Dec 10, 2024
- 9) Last day of GCH Fall semester: Dec 13, 2024
- 10) **Deadline** to register for SEU Spring A courses: Dec 13, 2024

*Christmas Break for GCH and SEU December 16, 2024 - January 6, 2025*

- 11) GCH Spring semester starts: Jan 6, 2025
- 12) IEW Composition 2 Course Access (16-week course): Jan 8, 2025
- 13) IEW Composition 2 Course Begins: Jan 15, 2025
- 14) **Deadline** to register for SEU Spring B courses: Feb 28, 2025
- 15) SEU Spring B course access: Mar 5, 2025
- 16) SEU Spring B course starts: Mar 12, 2025
- 17) **Deadline** to register for SEU Summer A courses: Apr 17, 2025
- 18) Last day for all SEU Spring courses: May 6, 2025
- 19) Last day for all GCH courses: May 23, 2025
- 20) **Deadline** to register for SEU Summer B courses: Jun 19, 2025

2. Print, sign, and scan the [Christian Halls](#) and [GCH](#) Student Record Release forms. Email the GCH copy to us at [info@generations.school](mailto:info@generations.school).
3. Visit the [Christian Halls Portal](#) to register. You will need 1) the student's social security number, 2) the Student Record Release form, and a method of payment for the \$50 CHI membership fee. This is the only out-of-pocket charge you will have. Everything else will be billed to GCH and we will invoice you.
